Cologne University of Applied Sciences (CUAS) is the largest school of its kind in Germany with approximately 17,000 students and 450 professors. 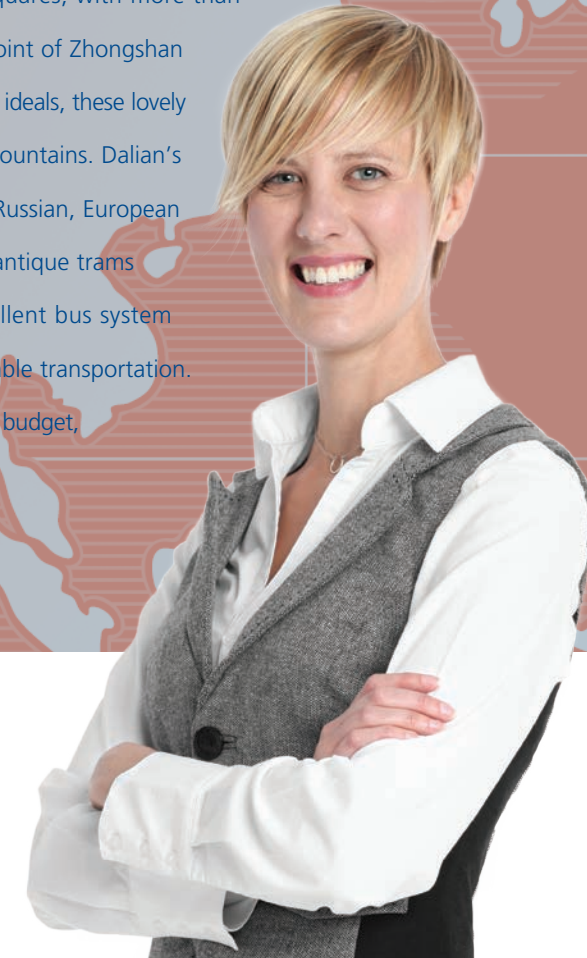

JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA, UNITED STATES

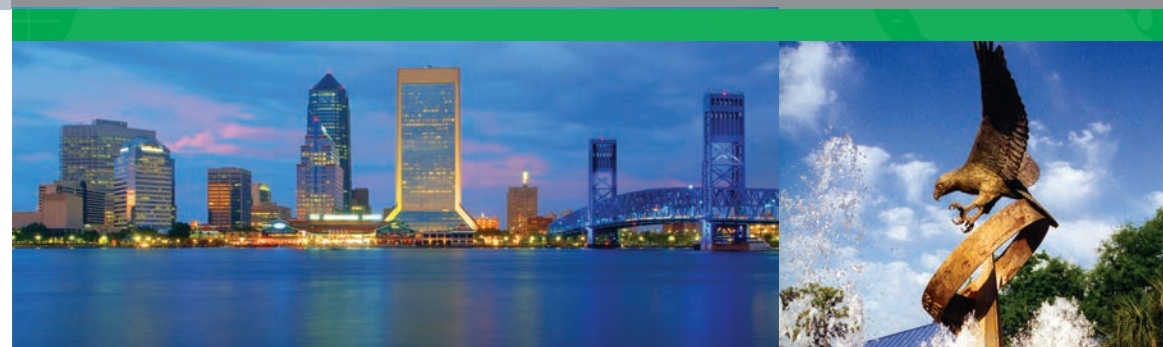
